We believe in supporting student wellness, good nutrition and regular physical activity as part of the learning environment. One goal of Aurora Public Schools is to provide students with a variety of opportunities to engage in physical activity. The playground and athletic fields are examples of areas reserved for Quest students to experience physical activity. Quest also occasionally shares the grounds with students from Crossroads and William Smith High School as well as outside agencies who rent the grounds. As a result of the number of groups using the playground and due to liability issues, **parents and siblings are NOT allowed on the playground during instructional hours, or when it is under contract from an outside agency.**

Safety and supervision is a hallmark of educators. Students who participate in school sponsored activities are under the supervision of coaches or sponsors. Unfortunately, staff members may not supervise the siblings of students who are participating in after school activities. Students must be picked up by 2:45 unless they are registered for an after school club or sport.

All students and siblings must be under the direct supervision of a parent during non-instructional time.
